

Committee Descriptions

Spirit Wear -Coordinate the selection, design, ordering, inventory, and online updates of sales for school spirit wear. Organize an on campus Sale in September during Dragon Dash. Periotic order maintenance.

Hospitality - Welcome new dragons by visiting the kinder classes on the 1st day of school and give a 5 Min PTO introduction. Welcome new staff members. Assist with Appreciation Days –1 lunch day in August, October, December, and 2 lunch days in May during Teacher Appreciation Week.

After School Treats– Weekly on Tuesday and Friday: Lead will handle scheduling. 1 or 2 adults to supervise as two 6th graders sell treats (Effort: 20mins each day)

Yearbook –Lead Chair to organize and create yearbook layout, distribute flyers and time deadlines. Committee Members to attend events helping take photos, post drop box collection of photos for each event and help with distribution in May.

Movie Days – Coordinate 1 or 2 movie days, after school on minimum days. Recruit volunteers to help with popcorn, supervision of students during movie and snack line.

Family Dinner Nights – Monthly family nights are when restaurants or recreation centers host a “Feickert Spirit Night.” A few calls to local businesses and distribution of flyers.

Fall Festival – Held in October. Help to coordinate the Volunteers, Game booths, Food, Prizes, Baskets/Raffle, Haunted House, and Rides. This job is best done with 5 or more committee members working together. Planning begins at least 8 weeks prior to the event. (Effort: Substantial, especially the week of the event).

Haunted House – This committee will decide on a theme, construct and take down haunted house for Fall Festival.

Holiday Store – Held in December, 7-8 weekdays during class time. Chair will purchase gifts to prepare for this event, set up and tear down (Effort: Varies, 5 -7 hours daily during event)

Mother Son Event – Organize a mother/son event in January or March. All ideas welcome! (Effort: varies: plan, set up, and clean up)

Friendship Grams - February- Purchase treats, send out flyers, fill orders and distribute to the classrooms. (Effort 4-5 hrs. in February only)

Princess Dance –Held in February. Plan a theme for the dance, food buffet, entertainment, photo booth, decorate, set up and clean up. (Effort: varies: all day commitment the day of the event)

Ice Cream Social Family Dance Night –Held in April/May. Committee chair will be responsible for securing volunteers for Food court, raffle basket, entertainment, and managing teacher volunteer schedules. (Effort: Varies and all day commitment the day of event)
